

Emeritus Status:

To become an Emeritus Member, a nominee must be presented to the National Council in a written request from his local chapter or a current or past National Officer, which cites the contributions made by the nominee to the successful operation of his local chapter and the National Organization.

- Rights, Duties, Obligations, and Honors for Emeritus Members
 - The National President shall prepare and deliver a letter to the newly elected Emeritus Member, citing his honors and contributions to the National Organization.
 - The local chapter shall develop a 90-second video featuring the new National Emeritus Member; this video shall be presented to the National Organization and made available to other local chapters for use at Pro-Duffer meetings and national events.
 - Emeritus Members will retain voting privileges at the national level.
 - Emeritus Members are a rich resource and will serve as advisors and consultants to promote the advancement of the local and National Pro-Duffer USA Organization.
 - Profiles of Emeritus Members shall be featured on The National Pro-Duffer USA website in a dedicated section titled “Pro-Duffer Profiles: Our National Emeritus Members.” These profiles will include the members’ photograph(s), name, chapter, Pro-Duffer history, and date of election, contributions, contact information, and a brief background summary
